Reg. 3 Entries

Reg. 4 Entry Fee

The entry fee is fixed by the organiser: **185 Euros (€)** (See Art. 4 of Category 1.3 “FIM Rendez-Vous Meritum” of the CTG).

Children between the ages of 8 and 12 will pay 50% of the adult entrance fee.

Children under the age of 8 will be admitted free of charge.

The organiser is not obligated to accept entries after the closing date for entries nor the entries made at the venue of the meeting.

If the organiser should accept entries after the closing date for entries, a surcharge of up to 15% to the entry fee may be imposed. Vacancy check prior to sending late entries is advised.

Reg. 5 Closing date for entries

The deadline for the entries and the booking of the accommodation is **30.04.2023**. The number of participants is limited to **120 persons**.

Reg. 6 Gifts, souvenirs and services for the participants

Every participant who has paid the registration fee will receive:

- Participation in the FIM Rendez-Vous Meritum (see program with two days of scheduled activities).
- 3 evening meals.
- 2 lunches.

Reg. 7 Accommodation

- 100% of campsite booking fee will be paid with the registration.
- 100% of the hotel booking fee will be paid with the registration.

The hotel or camping bookings will be made on the “accommodation” booking form.



The amounts due for the accommodation (in Euro) will be paid at the same time as the registration fee, before **30.04.2023** using the same two payment systems: bank transfer or bank card payment as in the case of entry fee (see “Reg. 4 Entry Fee”).

Reg. 9 Results and Classification

The FIM Rendez-Vous Meritum meeting is an international meeting of friendly character, which is reserved for a particular group of participants, so there is no classification.

Reg. 10 Cancellation of event

In accordance with the CTG the Organiser can cancel the event:

- if, at 30th April 2023, the number of entries is below 80.
- in the case of absolute necessity.



In the case of cancellation of the meeting, the participants who transmitted their entry forms before the closing entry date will be notified.

In case of cancellation due to COVID 19 restrictions, all payments made before the closing date will be refunded 100 %.

Reg. 11 Cancellation of registration

Cancellation of registration:

- In case of cancellation of registration, the participant shall transmit notification to the Organiser.
- Until 21th May 2023, 75% of the registration fee will be refunded.
- Between 21st May 2023 and 4th June 2023, 50% of the registration fee will be refunded.
- After 4th June 2023, no refund is possible.

Reg. 13 Protection of the environment

Motorcyclists are expected to consider other road users (See Art. 5.1 of the CTG and Art. 11.2 of Environmental Code).

“We must voluntarily add a greater degree of responsibility to our natural desire for individual mobility. We should try to achieve results on the basis of freedom of thought and movement, and exploit every opportunity to combine the pleasure of motorcycling more effectively with ecological and economic needs.”

- a) Individual motorcyclists should develop riding habits to ensure full integration with other types of road users.
- b) Ride safely and avoid aggressive and competitive riding.
- c) Save petrol and reduce pollution by avoiding unnecessary idling of engines.
- d) Ride politely and limit noise pollution by using your horn only in an emergency.
- e) Noise annoyance. Use a standard or another quiet exhaust system and keep audio systems at a low level.
- f) Use only routes which are open to motorcyclists.
- g) Ride like a professional by riding at a quiet and unobtrusive pace when riding in groups.
- h) Respect nature by not travelling on paths which risk being damaged beyond a point of natural recovery.
- i) Protect wildlife and its natural habitat by riding intelligently.
- j) Ensure that your used oil, tyres, batteries and other recyclable items are properly recycled.
- k) Encourage a rational use of fuel and space economy by using motorcycles instead of driving automobiles.
- l) Remember that our cities and our roads are not circuits.
